


Ansons Bay Local Township Plan

2018-2020



During the development of Council's Strategic Plan, Council advised township meetings that we would come back and talk to individual communities about what they saw as important for the future in their township and how Council could work with them to develop these ideas.

On Saturday, 9th June 2018 we held a "drop in session" at Ansons Bay where Council officers met with community members seeking their feedback on the following issues:

- Infrastructure
- Environment
- Other issues

This Local Township Plan will take into account Ansons Bay's future addressing issues around community needs.

Results and emerging issues from the drop in session:

Common themes that arose from this session were the need for an increase in signage for a range of purposes including tourism and access to public areas; enhancing access to key beaches; and telecommunications.

Other themes that arose were:

- Community transport for elderly and or unwell to appointments in St Helens.
- Recycling at the Ansons Bay tip.
- Town maintenance.

The township plan will address:

- Protecting and enhancing the environmental values of Ansons Bay.
- Ensuring there are enough community facilities to service Ansons Bay's future needs.
