

## When will the upgrade works on the new bridge commence?

Work on the pedestrian pathway is programmed to start on the 18<sup>th</sup> of February 2021.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and road users.

One lane will be closed with reduced speed limits in place on the new Scamander Bridge as required during work hours.

No works will be undertaken during weekends and public holidays

## When will the Bridge demolition begin?

Once the pedestrian upgrades on the new bridge have been completed, the demolition of the old bridge will begin, this is anticipated to be the end of March.

## Will the old pedestrian bridge still be in use while the new bridge is being upgraded?

Yes, the old bridge will remain open until work on the new bridge is completed. Pedestrians will be able to walk across the Scamander River by either using the old bridge or one of the open pedestrian access ways on the new bridge (only one side of the bridge pedestrian access will be closed at any one time). There will be detour notices and paths provided for pedestrians.

## What side of the old bridge will the demolition works begin?

The works will be done from both sides of the bridge at any one time.
