



Great Eastern Drive – Diana’s Basin to St Helens Overtaking Lanes

Start of work on Great Eastern Drive, Overtaking Lanes Diana’s Basin to St Helens from 1st March 2021.

The Tasmanian Government is funding road improvements on the Tasman Highway including overtaking lanes between Diana’s Basin and St Helens.

The Department of State Growth will start constructing overtaking lanes in each direction and other general road improvements.

We will be working between 7.00am and 6.00pm from Monday to Friday and, if required, between 7.00am and 6.00pm Saturday and expect to complete the works by the end of December 2021, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities mid-morning to late afternoon and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of workers and road users. Lane closures and a reduced speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. After hours speed restrictions will apply. Motorists should allow up to 15 minutes extra travel time during long term and bituminous surfacing works. Please keep to speed limits and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs.
