\* Under section 50 of the Act a person must not keep or allow to be kept on any premises, without a licence, more than 2 dogs over the age of 6 months; or more than 4 working dogs over the age of 6 months. A working dog means a dog used principally for the droving or tending livestock; or detecting illegal substances; or searching, tracking or rescuing, or working with police officers. A licence application may be obtained from the council where the dogs are to be kept.

\*\* Under section 6 of the Act the owner of the dog is taken to be:

- (a) in the case of a registered dog, the person whose name the dog is registered; or
- (b) in the case of an unregistered dog, the person who ordinarily keeps the dog; or
- (c) in the case of a child's pet, the child's parent or guardian.

\*\*\* If the dog has been notified under section 30 of the Act as a guard dog to guard premises that are not residential, the address of the premises guarded by the dog is to be notified.

### PRIVACY STATEMENT

Personal information will be used solely by Council for that primary purpose or directly related purpose. Council may disclose the information to other regulatory organisations where required to by law; officers of Break O'Day Council; data service providers engaged by Council from time to time; and any other agent to Council.
