During the development of Council's Strategic Plan Council advised townships that we would come back and talk to our communities about what they saw as important for the future and how Council could work with them to develop these ideas.

On Wednesday 21 November, 2018 we held a "drop in session" at St Marys where Council officers met with community members seeking their feedback on the following issues:

- Infrastructure;
- Services; and
- Other issues

This Township Plan will take into account St Mary's future addressing issues around community needs.



Results and emerging issues from the drop in session:

A common theme that arose from this session was the need for improved tourism infrastructure and signage

Other themes that arose were:

- Walking/cycle trail along the old railway line St Marys to Fingal; and
- More services for St Marys

The township plan will address:

- Protecting and enhancing the environmental values of St Marys;
- Township maintenance; and
- Supporting tourism.
