## What is changing?

### Start Date – 7 July

Break O'Day Council is improving efficiency and reliability by taking over kerbside recycling collection.

This change will deliver better value for our community.

The new collection calendar will start on Monday 7 July. This means the first week of July will still be the old collection schedule.

## What do you need to know?

Waste and Recycling will now alternate weekly.

Check the table below for your town's new collection day.

Tuesday	St Helens
Wednesday	St Marys, Scamander, Upper Scamander
Thursday	Fingal, Mangana, Mathinna, Cornwall, Upper Esk
Friday	Beaumaris, Dianas Basin, Chain of Lagoons, Douglas River, Falmouth, Four Mile Creek, Seymour.
