

Making a Representation

During the exhibition period which, is from 11 October to 13 December, anyone may make a representation on the Draft Break O'Day LPS.

Any documents regarding the LPS are available on our webpage including fact sheets and links to relevant information.

It is important to remember that any representations **must** relate to matters in the Draft LPS.

Representations **cannot** be accepted on the following matters:

- Content of a provision of the State Planning Provisions (SPP);
- Matters that do not relate to the contents or merit of the draft LPS.

How do I make a representation?

You can make a written representation on the BODC Draft LPS by writing to the General Manager during the prescribed advertising period (11 October to December 13). Please address representations to:

What happens after a representation is made?

Council will consider the representations received and prepare a report considering the merits of each representation which we will then send to the Tasmanian Planning Commission (TPC).

The TPC will then hold public hearings where public representations and council's report are considered. We will notify the community of any public hearings via our website, social media and the newsletter.
