

RURAL RESOURCES – RURAL OR AGRICULTURAL ZONE

- The Rural Zone and Agriculture Zone in the State Planning Provisions reflect a recalibration of the Rural Resource Zone and the Significant Agricultural Zone of the current Interim Planning Scheme.
- The State Government commissioned a State-wide Agricultural Land Mapping Project with the primary aim of identifying Tasmania's existing and potential agricultural land, and to provide guidance to local planning authorities on the spatial application of the new Agriculture Zone
- This is of particular weight given the Break O'Day Interim Planning Scheme did not include any land mapped within the Significant Agriculture Zone.
- The Agriculture Zone is intended to provide a much broader scope for the identification and protection of agricultural land in Tasmania, with priority given to agricultural uses.
- The Rural Zone provides for the remaining rural land where there is limited or no potential for agriculture.
